What's happening with Green Certification?

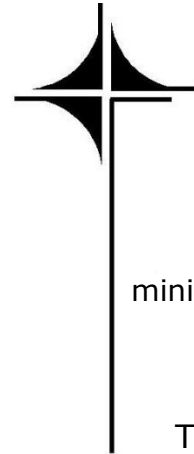
On Earth Day, we announced that Trinity was seeking Green Certification, working on meeting the requirements of the three levels of Greening

Sacred Spaces program. A Green Team with representatives of various committees, Ministers, a Co-Chair of Council and other interested persons has met twice to look at what we have done with respect to the requirements of the Light Green level.

Various people have been getting involved - perhaps you noticed the nice border of annuals that the Sunday School planted around our garden. Property Committee is re-examining an energy audit report done 15 years ago to see what additional improvements could be made.

Although only 10 of the 31 requirements are needed to apply for the Light Green level, we determined that we actually have completed twice that many, 20! In the last week of May, we submitted our application for the Light Green level and hope to receive our certificate in about a month.

We have now started working to complete at least 10 of the 30 requirements of the Medium Green level. Stay tuned for more updates and opportunities to get involved in the fall. Have a Green summer!
